TOOLS NEEDED:

- sewing machine: any sewing machine with a straight stitch will work for this project.
- sharp fabric scissors
- scissors for cutting paper pattern
- hemostats for turning and stuffing the doll 10" large or 6" medium
- pencil or fabric marking pen
- long doll needle
- pins or clips to hold fabric together
- book or cardboard to wrap yarn hair
- (optional) light pad for tracing

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- skin-tone fabric (less than 1/4 yard) cotton knit or cotton woven
- bodice fabric your choice (less than 1/4 yard)
- skirt fabric your choice (18" long x 4" wide)
- fusible interfacing project photos use Pellon 950F fusible
- sewing machine thread to match body or skintone
- strong thread for hand sewing (match body & yarn hair)
- 1/4" elastic for skirt
- yarn of your choice for hair
- optional for face: plastic safety eyes, button eyes, fabric markers, paint pens, embroidery floss.
- poly stuffing
- optional rolled hem foot for sewing machine
